LEED CERTIFICATION

Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design

Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design is a green building certification system developed by the US Green Building Council (USGBC). LEED “points” are awarded on a scale from 1 to 100. Credits are assigned that reflect potential environmental impact. The use of “low emitting” coatings on interior surfaces during construction are awarded 1 point towards certification and equal a potential of 4.2 credits available.

QHF coatings are usually applied by sign manufacturers in a controlled manufacturing environment. Signage painted in this controlled environment and then installed “on site” will not impact interior or exterior environmental air quality at the building site and will not earn LEED certification points or credits.

Select Primers, Topcoats and Additives are low in VOC’s and meet or exceed the requirements of USGBC’s Green Seal GS-11, but LEED points are not earned, however our eco-friendly line of products do contribute to making our planet a more colorful, greener place to live.
